

Effective **Monday, January 3, 2022** – The Salvation Army Ray & Joan Kroc Corps Community Center – Chicago will enter a new mandate under the City of Chicago that will require members and participants to provide proof of full vaccination as well as continued to wear masks.

**Please note:**

1. All members and participants ages 5 and older must present their Covid-19 Vaccination Record Card showing **full** vaccination status as defined by the CDC (*2 doses – Pfizer and Moderna; 1 dose – Johnson & Johnson*). Mobile photos of Cards are accepted.
2. Individuals 16 and older must present a valid photo identification card along with their Covid-19 Vaccination Record Card.

**Covid Mandate – Frequently Asked Questions**

- If I am not vaccinated will my membership be cancelled?
  - No, The Kroc Center will not automatically cancel your membership.
- What happens if a member or participant who is unvaccinated scans in?
  - Any individual not vaccinated will be stopped by the Front Desk Attendant and informed of the mandate. Therefore, individuals will not be allowed entry into The Kroc Center until there are changes in the City of Chicago mandate or until they are able to provide proof of vaccination.
- I attend Sunday Church Services do I need to provide proof of vaccination?
  - No, the City of Chicago will allow our time of worship to be exempt from providing proof of vaccination. However, attending any other weekday ministry programs or when utilizing the facility outside of worship services on Sunday, the vaccine mandate applies.
- My child attends Aftercare / Teenzone / Kidzone at The Kroc. Will they need to provide proof of their vaccination?
  - Yes. Due to the nature of this facility, all individuals ages 5 and older, utilizing the space will need to provide proof of being fully vaccinated.
- I am registered for a program class, and I am not vaccinated or am unable to provide proof of vaccination. What should I expect?
  - A staff person from the department will contact you prior to January 3<sup>rd</sup> to update you on the mandate and to remind you to bring proof of vaccination prior to the start of class. If you are unable to provide proof or are not vaccinated, you may request a refund. Please allow 3 to 5 business days for processing. Credits will not be issued.
- Could my class be cancelled or postponed?
  - Yes, based on the mandate some classes may be postponed until further notice. A staff person will contact you prior to the start of class and a refund will be processed. Please allow 3 to 5 business day for processing. Credits will not be issued.
- I have an Event Rental scheduled or planned. Will my attendees be required to show proof of vaccination?
  - Yes, all attendees will be required to show proof of vaccination prior to entry into the center.
